Dear Ms. Pacheco:

Appellee/Cross-Appellant Jo N. Hopper has filed her *Unopposed (In Part) First Motion for Extension of Time to File Brief*. This Motion seeks a 46-day extension of time to file her Brief. A draft of this Motion was prepared prior to conferencing with counsel for the Appellants Stephen B. Hopper and Laura S. Wassmer ("Appellants") and Appellee JP Morgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("Appellee"). Upon conferencing with all counsel of record, we were advised that Appellants were not opposed to the 46-day extension sought by Mrs. Hopper, while Appellee was not opposed to a 30-day extension, but is opposed to a 46-day extension. This is clearly noted and accurately reflected in the Certificate of Conference attached to the Motion filed with this Court. However, in revising the initial draft to conform the draft to the actual agreement, we inadvertently missed one paragraph, paragraph 10, of the draft Motion. That is, we overlooked editing that paragraph to make it consistent with the Certificate of Conference.


