This document is the appraisal of the wine collection of the estate of Max Hopper located at 9 Robledo Drive, Dallas, Texas 75230. This collection was inventoried in August 2010 and the appraisal was done in between that time and October 2010.

The figures shown are the current fair market value of the wines as of Fall 2010. The value is determined by researching recent auction sales, current retail price, and original retail price if available, with a plus/minus adjustment determined by condition of the wines, demand and rarity.

I personally examined each and every bottle of the collection located in boxes on the floor or in shelves, and bottles in sturdy built-in wine racks. If the cases were sealed with the original seal, I spot checked the wines and then counted bottles per case, as 12, 6, 4, 3, 2, or 1 per case as was evidenced.

The wines were collected by Mr. and Mrs. Hopper over three decades or more. They have been and currently are secure in a perfectly chilled and monitored wine room that has good circulation, temperature and humidity. There is no light unless someone enters the cellar. It is in the center of the second floor of the 9 Robledo Drive home. There are no vibrations and it does not have an outside wall. Storage is impeccable and could not be improved upon.

Some of the white wines are quite old and tired for the type of wine they are. Some of these wines do not age well, and some age but not usually as long as they have been held. I assigned \$0 if there is no question that they are going to be bad. I assigned \$1-\$5 if there is a chance that the wine is drinkable. The only way to tell is to taste some of the wines. Some whites are young or have aged well.

Red wines of any quality have a better chance of aging. I assigned a few dollars to the lighter reds that should have been drunk young or that show age or cork damage. You have some reds that had value and may or may not still be delicious, or at least drinkable. Those show higher values which have been discounted.

The bulk of the red wines is in superb condition and have added value.

The value of the wines has been indicated as to each bottle by divided the whole collection into three categories as follows:

Class A -- valuable and/ or rare wines in perfect condition that would allow resale.


Class B -- Wines in perfect to good condition that are not prime candidates for resale because the lot is too small or the wine is generally available and not rare. This also include currently acquired young every day wines and wines with a personal reference to the family such as special occasion or autograph. These can be enjoyed either now or later depending on age.

Class C -- Wines of little or no value that are probably not drinkable.

The total value of the collection is \$145,159.00




