**AMENDED APPLICATION FOR THIRD EXTENSION
OF TIME IN WHICH TO FILE
INVENTORY, APPRAISEMENT AND LIST OF CLAIMS**

NOW COMES JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("Applicant" herein), in its capacity as Independent Administrator of the above-referenced estate, who would show the Court the following:

1. On December 31, 2010, this Court entered its Order Approving Applicant's Application for Second Extension of Time in Which to File Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims, extending the due date to March 28, 2011.

2. On March 25, 2011, Applicant filed an Application for Third Extension of Time in Which to File Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims, and now desires to file this Amended Application for Third Extension of Time in Which to File Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims (the "Amended Application").

3. Despite diligent efforts by the Applicant to complete the work required to file a full and complete inventory, appraisal and list of claims by the extended due date, the Applicant was unable to file on that date due to the Applicant's inability to obtain a complete listing and valuation of the assets owned by the Decedent. In support of this Amended Application, Applicant would show the Court the following:

(i) Decedent died intestate, and there have been difficulties and some controversy among the beneficiaries and the Decedent's surviving spouse in determining which properties were separately owned by Decedent, which properties were separately owned by the surviving spouse, and which properties were community owned by Decedent and the surviving spouse. Applicant continues work to resolve these issues with all interested parties and each of their attorneys.

(ii) Applicant has obtained additional appraisals which include property that was not available to be examined previously. It has been necessary for Applicant to order amended appraisals on real property as the original appraisal did not include accurate information concerning specific items affixed to the property.

(iii) Applicant has encountered some delay in assembling and delivering the personal jewelry owned by the Decedent to an independent appraiser. Delivery was completed on or about April 13, 2011, but the appraisal has not yet been completed.


(iv) Applicant continues to request information relating to private equity investments, but still lacks some of the information necessary to obtain valuations of such investments.

(v) Applicant continues efforts to resolve questions of ownership of accounts in financial institutions.

4. Applicant is diligently working to obtain full and complete information as to the nature, extent and value of the assets of the Estate so that a correct and complete Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims can be filed in this case.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that an extension of time in which to file the inventory, appraisal and list of claims for the Estate be granted until June 27, 2011 and that this Court enter such further orders and grant such further relief as Applicant may be entitled to receive at law or in equity.
